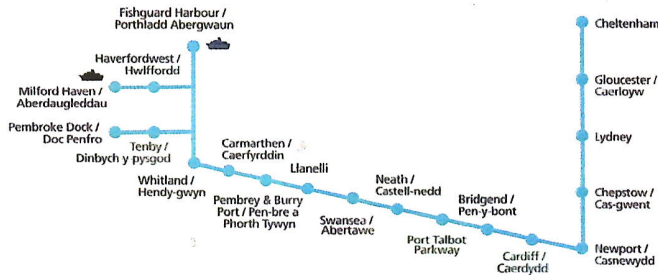

Dear Alec,

Many thanks for getting in touch.

The land used as the extended car park is owned by Network Rail. Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) took on the lease in April 2016 in order to address the lack of car parking capacity at the station. After gaining planning permission, GCC installed lighting, cleared the site and carried out minor works to bring the area up to a suitable standard for parking. The work has been overseen by GCC's Asset Management Property Services (AMPS). The extended car park is temporary with the current lease running until March 2018. GCC is investigating options for other stakeholders to take on the lease when it runs out, should Network Rail agree for the car park to continue.

The car park opened on Thursday 16th February 2017 and has space for approximately 90 cars.

Fares & tickets for the Forest of Dean

Single fares are available for any one journey and start from as little as £1.10. If you're coming back on the same day, ask your driver for a **Return**.

A **Dayrider** or **Explorer** may be the best ticket for some journeys – available from your driver or as a mobile ticket from the Stagecoach App.

Our **Megarider** will be the best value ticket for your frequent trips with us. We sell 1-week tickets on the Stagecoach App, online or from your driver; 4-week tickets online and from your driver; and 13-week & 52-week tickets online only. Megarider tickets are usually sold on our smartcards – please note that a new smartcard sold by our driver will attract a one-off fee of 50p per card. You may top-up any existing smartcard for free, and we encourage you to register it online with us for additional security.

Forest Dayrider & Forest Megarider tickets are valid for any journey on **23, 24, 30 & 31, 33** (Ross-on-Wye to Gloucester), **32 & 132, 34, 35, 40 & 40A, 746**.

Hereford Dayrider & Hereford Megarider tickets are valid for any journey on **33** (Ross-on-Wye to Hereford), **36** and **44**.

Explorer & Megarider Gold tickets cover travel across the full Stagecoach West network from Herefordshire & Gloucestershire into Swindon and Wiltshire. Try our **Family & Friends Explorer** if you're travelling in a group of up to four people.

Concessionary travelcards are accepted on our local bus services according to the terms and conditions of each local authority. To use your card, simply place it on the ticket machine reader and state your destination to the driver. You won't receive a ticket as we record your journey electronically.

Child single & return fares are available at a discounted rate for children aged 5 to 15. Up to four children aged under 5 may travel free of charge with a responsible passenger, providing that they do not occupy a seat to the exclusion of a fare-paying passenger. Our buses have space available for push chairs and buggies, but please remember that the priority wheelchair space must be vacated if required for a wheelchair user.

Change will be given whenever our drivers are able to do so. If our driver is unable to give change, we'll issue you with a voucher so that you can reclaim the money from us. These vouchers may be used as payment for another journey or can be swapped for your money by another Stagecoach bus driver.

We can currently only accept **cash fares** on our buses. If you prefer to pay electronically, day and weekly tickets are available on the Stagecoach Bus App and longer-term tickets from our website.

Guide & Assistance Dogs may travel with us free of charge at any time. Other dogs will be charged a flat fare of £1.00 per journey.

Useful Information

Timetable notes

Regular Bus tickets

On most bus services a variety of tickets can be purchased from the driver for single journeys and day returns as well as day tickets that allow travel on many others if not all bus services run by a bus company. On some journeys the driver can sell tickets that are valid for more than one day - allowing travel for a week or 4 weeks or for 10 or 12 trips. Types of tickets vary by operator and the larger operators offer day explorers, weekly and monthly tickets for use on their services only. Please check with the operator on costs and conditions of use. When boarding the bus it is appreciated if you have the correct fare.

Fares

On most bus services children under the age of 5 can travel free when accompanied by an adult. Reduced fares are usually available for children but at which such reductions apply may vary, depending on the operator.

On some services, child fares may not be available during the morning rush hour on Mondays to Fridays. Please check with the operator on costs and conditions of use.

What is Lydney Dial-A-Ride?

Lydney Dial-A-Ride is a friendly door-to-door transport service for those people who do not have their own transport and are unable to use public transport. We have been established for over 25 years and provide vital transport services to the elderly, disabled and rurally isolated.

We operate a fleet of fully accessible minibuses capable of carrying wheelchair passengers, and a volunteer based car service. The service covers Lydney, Coleford, Cinderford and the surrounding area

Who can use the service?

The Dial-A-Ride service aims to provide transport for the following groups:

People without their own transport who:

- Are elderly or frail
- Have a disability (permanent or temporary)
- Need to use a wheelchair
- Able bodied people with no access to public transport and do not have frequent/convenient access to a car

If you fit into any of the above categories then why not try this service? A few simple questions over the telephone, or filling in and returning a membership form are available from our head office located at Lydney Bus Station on Hamms Road, to determine eligibility.



Where can I go?

If you suffer from restricted mobility this service can provide an opportunity for you to go to:

- Shops
- Health appointments
- Hairdressers
- Post Office
- Opticians
- Library
- Lunch Clubs

Weddings, parties and other social events etc.

How do I book a seat?

To book a seat simply telephone the Dial-A-Ride office on 01594 843809 between 9.00am and 4.30pm (Monday to Friday), giving your membership number and details of the journey you wish to make. If you don't have a telephone please ask someone else to contact us on your behalf. When booking a Journey please give us 24 hours notice if possible to avoid disappointment.

What does it cost?

An annual registration fee allows unlimited use, and journeys are fare-based. We are a non-profit organisation and all fees and fares go towards supporting the service.

For Groups

Minibuses can be available with a driver on evenings and weekends for other charitable organisations, clubs, societies, voluntary and community groups, schools and colleges. Call 01594 843809 for further details.

Voluntary Car Service

Alongside the traditional Lydney Dial-A-Ride, we also offer a Voluntary Car Service. The volunteer car service is available for medical appointments and visiting relatives, both within and outside of the county. We have a number of cars available, charged on a per-mile basis.

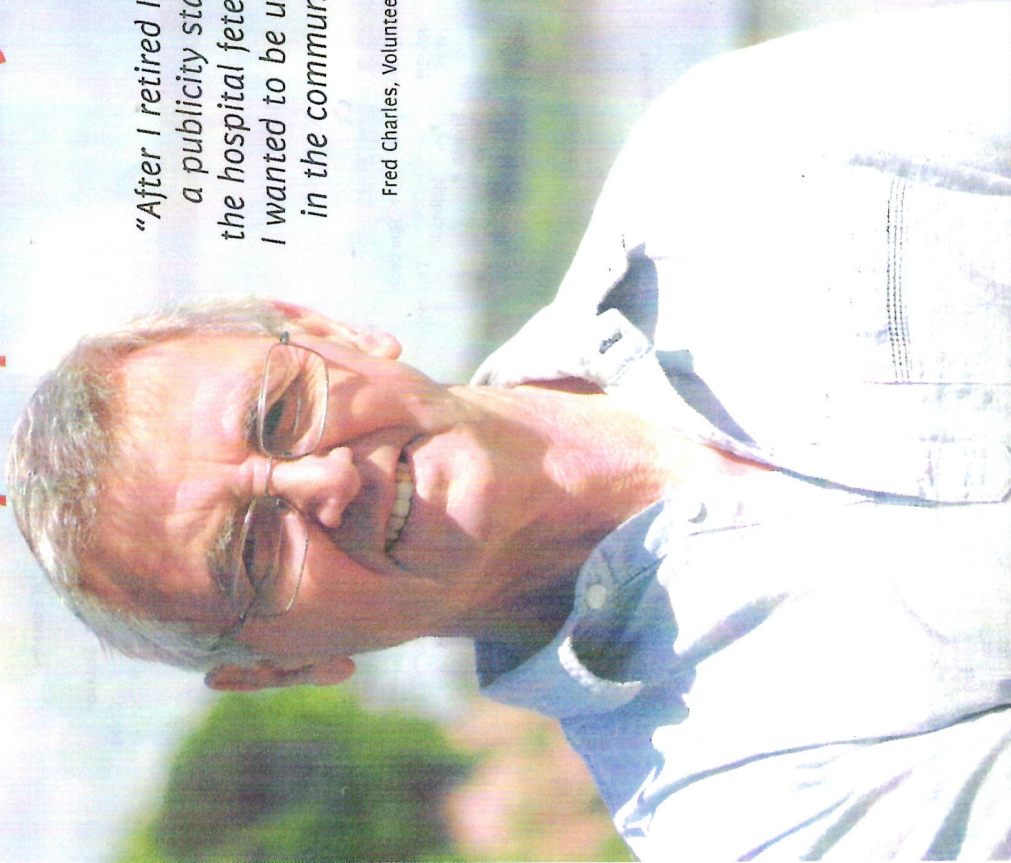

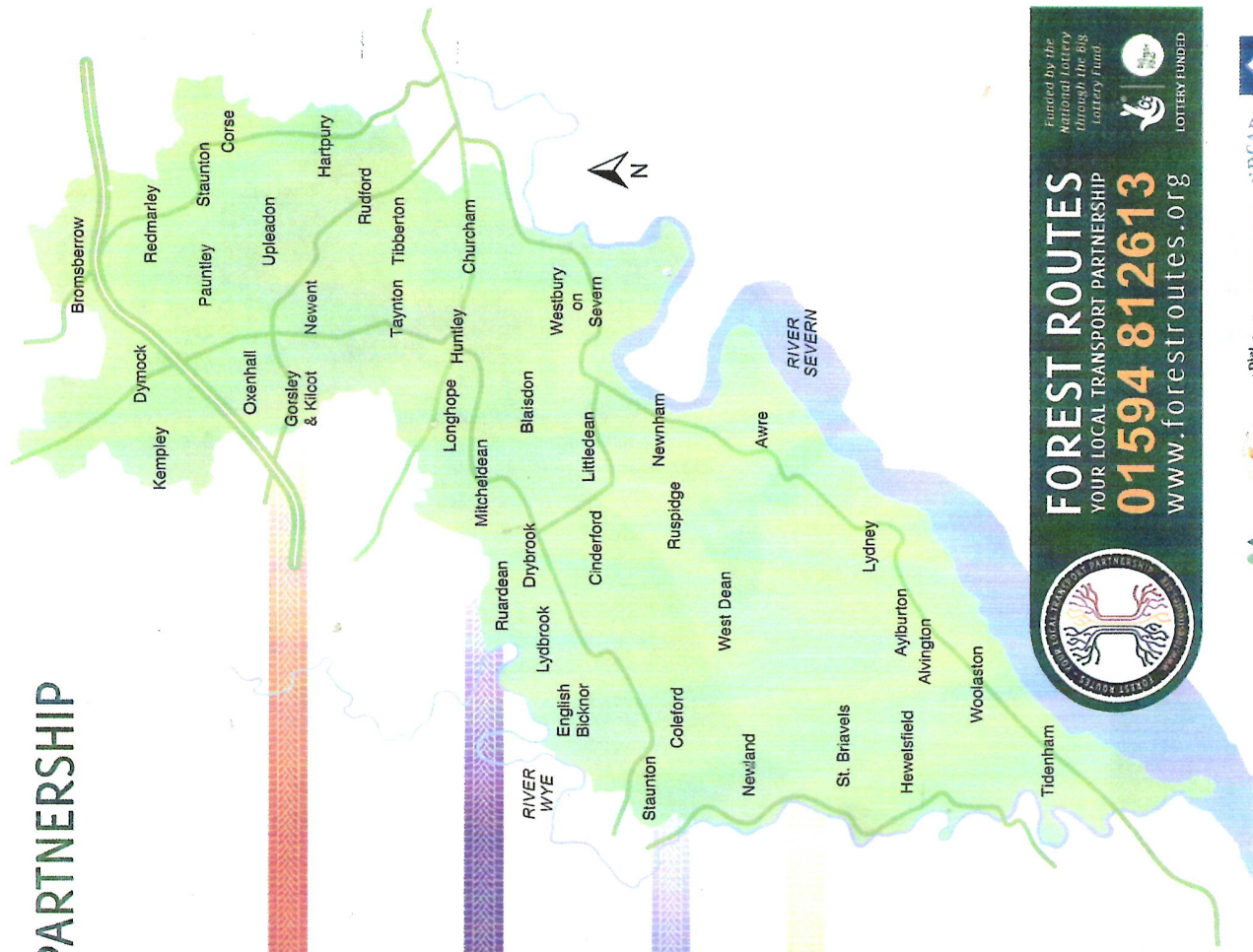
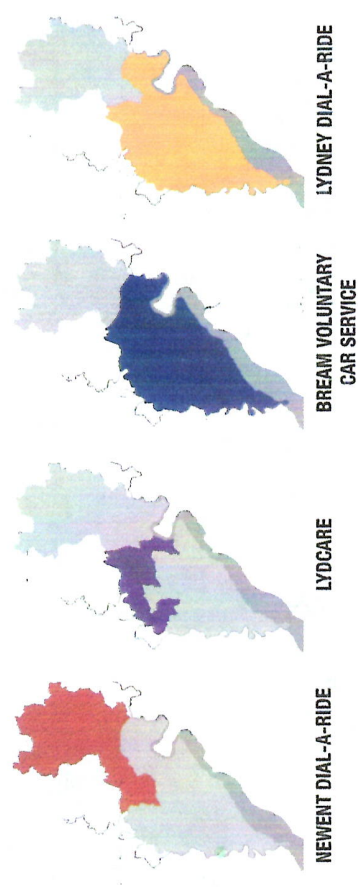

Summary

1 Train Tickets.

Can be purchased in advance on line, by phone, at the station ticket machine or on the train.

If purchased well in advance can prove to be much cheaper.

Tickets are National and can be used on any train regardless of operator or how many time you change.

2 Bus tickets.

Are very different and are specific to each operator. Most operators do saver tickets for daily or weekly travel, but not all. For example James Bevan do no saver tickets.

3 Taxis.
