Choosing a tree contractor



If you need a tree surgeon or consultant the information below may help you.

• Tree Surgeons carry out tree maintenance (pruning, bracing operations), tree felling (including dismantling of dangerous trees or

trees in confined spaces). They also provide general advice on tree management and maintenance.

- We would advise that you obtain a written specification for the work and agree the specification and price prior to obtaining the relevant permissions and commissioning the contractor.
- Tree Advisors/Arboriculturists provide specialist opinion on tree health, safety, preservation, trees and buildings, planning and other law.
- The Arboricultural Association <u>www.trees.org.uk</u> provides a guidance leaflet on the questions to ask when selecting a tree contractor.



- Annotated & recently dated photographs of the tree(s) must be submitted.

Application/Notice Types: Application/Notices will be classified as either MAJOR or MINOR dependant on the works proposed.

MAJOR:

- Removal of a single branch of more than 120mm diameter at trunk - Crown Thinning over 15% meeting point - Removal of multiple branches

MINOR:

- Crown Reductions under - Removal of a single 15% branch under 120mm - Crown Thinning under diameter at trunk meeting 15% point.

Multiple works that would be independently classed as MINOR may be reclassified as MAJOR, if the overall impact is likely to be greater. In this case the applicant will be informed at the validation stage.
